Date: Wednesday, September 8, 2004

Description: Finding, downloading, listening to, importing and exporting standard MIDI files.

Software: Safari, Word, Adobe Acrobat, Finale, QuickTime, e-mail program of choice.

Assignment:

- Using Safari's Google search engine, locate at least 10 free MIDI files and download them to your student folder.
- Subsequently, download the files posted on [Professor Calle's website](#).
- Launch the QuickTime application.
- In Quicktime's file menu, open a MIDI file. Listen to it. Repeat the procedure for each file. If you find a great file, e-mail to yourself and [Professor Calle](#).
- Choose your favorite MIDI file and label it with a * after the name. Example:
Yeah*.mid
- Launch the application Finale on the computer.
- Import the MIDI file.
- Save the existing score to your student drive.
- Extract the bass part.
- Save the bass part to your drive.
- Create a PDF for the bass part.
- Save the PDF to your drive.
- E-mail a copy of the PDF to yourself and to [Professor Calle](#).
